Mary in Africa

Truly, the harvest here is ready. We praise G for bringing new workers to the field. On January 6 we welcomed a Tanzanian family to our area. While their house was being repaired I had the joy of hosting them at my house. It was a wonderful time of getting to know them and showing them how we live in this community (they come from the opposite side of Tanzania and their home culture is very different from here). They lived with me for a month and just this week moved to their own house in the village across the river. They will continue meeting with the men and women who have already started studying the B, and building relationships with those in their community. I will continue visiting that village weekly to "co-teach" the group of women in one of the villages. For the last 3 Sundays we have had about 7 women meeting together to hear the Word of G! Please pray for acceptance in their new village and for the spread of the G in this newly opened area. Pray for protection for the women here. This new village does not yet have piped water, so the women wash laundry and gather water in a crocodile-infested river. There is a project in place to pipe water from the river to the village. Please pray also for this time of learning the local language and culture, and building relationships. It is a humbling and daunting task, but the rewards are worth it! Thank you for joining with me in prayer support. G answers prayers in wonderful ways! I am praying for you as well, so please let me know if there are specific requests I can be bringing before the F on your behalf.
